
















# <u>Restricted Burning Period</u> <u>14 February 2018 – 30 April 2018</u>

The Restricted Burning Period commenced on the 14 February and will be in place until 30 April. A 'Permits to Burn' is required for all fires lit during this period including burning backyard garden refuse. A Permit is free of charge and can be obtained from the Shire Office or your local Fire Control Officer.

A Fire Control Officer can refuse to issue a Permit if he or she believes that there is a risk of escape due to seasonal conditions.

Please note any fire you light is your reasonability to manage. Any fire lit without a Permit may incur a \$250.00 infringement if reported to authorities.

Do you have the skills, time and know-how to






