Community Grants Program 2020/2021 Applications Open

The Shire of Katanning Community Grants Program (CGP) provides funding support in two categories of up to, and over \$5,000 each, to enable the Shire to support projects that promote community capacity, improve social participation and inclusion as well as enhance community harmony and social cohesion.

Each application will be assessed against the following criteria. Does the project:

- Meet a community need?
 - Benefit a sufficiently broad, or diverse, target group?
 - Align with the Shire of Katanning community vision?
 - Does the organisation have the capacity to undertake and manage the project?
 - Does the application represent value for money?
- Collaborative community wide projects are encouraged.

To submit an application for CGP funding, applicants must complete an application form located on the Shire of Katanning website at www.katanning.wa.gov.au or at the Shire of Katanning administration building.

Please read the guidelines located on the website prior to submitting an application.

Applications are to be received by Tuesday 30

November 2020.

Green Waste Collection Reminder

The Shire of Katanning is offering a free Green Waste verge collection commencing Monday 9 November 2020 until Friday 13 November 2020.

Do not obstruct the footpath or your normal bin services and ensure waste does not obstruct line of sight of pedestrians or cars.

Residents are reminded that this is a Green Waste collection only. Contaminated garden waste will not be removed.

Lawn clippings, cuttings and leaves must be in boxes or bags. To prevent damage, do not obstruct Telstra pits, water meters or power domes with green waste as mechanical equipment may be used. Please trim tree branches and pruning's to a max of 1.5m (5ft) and place bundles in line with kerb.

Katanning Community Food Trailer Launch

The Shire of Katanning launched their new mobile community food trailer on Wednesday 4 November 2020. The trailer was on display for local Katanning businesses to view and nominate a business or community group into a draw to win the first hire of the trailer free of charge.

The trailer will provide easy access to a resource that will grow and support food businesses and community groups in town. Bruce Manning, Chief Executive Officer of the Great Southern Development Commission and Liz Guidera, Katanning Shire President, proudly presented the new mobile food trailer and invited the community to explore the interior.

Katanning is known for its diverse community and variety of foods from around the world which is showcased during the annual Katanning Harmony Festival in March drawing large crowds every year.

The Shire of Katanning's small business support program has had success in supporting the community in developing their

local food businesses. The food trailer will be a means to support locals by providing a mechanism to expand their food businesses and reduce economic risk along the way.

The Shire of Katanning's food trailer is funded by the Great Southern Development Commission and was designed and built by Elross Caravans and Mobile Solutions.

COUNCIL HIGHLIGHTS

At the October Ordinary Council Meeting held on Tuesday 27 October 2020, the following items were considered:

Development Application – Holiday Accommodation
Council approved application for Holiday Accommodation on portion of Lot 70 Warren Road, Katanning, following advertising and re-referral to the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES).

The Holiday Accommodation will include eight Chalets, four Caravan Sites with ensuites and Camper's Kitchen and Entry/Security Gate subject to conditions.

Review of Wards and Representation
Council in accordance with Schedule 2.2 (9) of the *Local Government Act 1995*, recommends to the Local Government Advisory Board for implementation at the 2021 local government

elections that:

1. An order be made under section 2.18 of the *Local Government Act 1995* to reduce the number of offices of councillor for the Shire of Katanning from nine (9) to seven (7);
2. The no wards system be maintained; and
3. As near as half the number of offices of councillor (three (3)) be elected at the 2021 local government elections.

Piesse Park Subdivision Road Name

Council recommends to the Geographic Names Committee to name the new road at the Piesse Park Subdivision Kaatanup Loop.

The use of the name is supported by the Katanning Noongar Leadership Group.
