- Parking Local Law 2022**

Effect: Effective and consistent parking practices within the Shire of Kojonup.
- Cats Local Law 2022**  
Purpose: To address the impounding of cats, requirements and limitations on the keeping of cats, and the requirements of approved kennel establishments within the Shire of Kojonup.

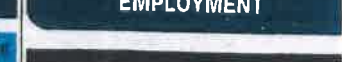

### PROPOSED LOCAL PLANNING POLICY FOR KOJONUP AERODROME

The Shire of Kojonup, at its 16 November 2021 Ordinary Meeting, adopted a draft Policy to deal with development of land at the Kojonup Aerodrome for airport service businesses.
