What to do during a Severe Weather Warning

Dangerous storms are the most common natural hazard in Australia.

Every year from May to October, storms including tornados, lightning, hail, flash flooding and gale force winds cause major destruction to the southern half of WA.

As storms are unpredictable and generally impact a small area, their devastating impact is often underestimated.

Storms not only cause damage to homes, property and businesses, they also pose a threat to people,

animals and the environment.

Keep up-to-date during a storm by visiting emergency.wa.gov.au, calling 13 DFES, following the Department of Fire and Emergency Services (DFES) on Facebook and Twitter and listening to ABC local radio and other news bulletins.

If you find yourself in a Severe Weather Warning area, the following tips are advised by the Department of Fire and Emergency Services:

- Store or weigh down loose objects around your home, like outdoor furniture that could be picked up and thrown by strong winds.
- Ensure your emergency kit is complete, including a battery operated radio, torch, spare batteries and first aid kit.
- Ensure pets and animals are in a safe area.
- Move vehicles under cover.
- Charge mobile phones and devices in case of a power outage.
- Unplug electrical appliances and avoid using landlines telephones if there is lightning.
- Securely moor boats.

Gallery Exhibition: Outback Blues

The complex and endearing artwork of The Outback Blues on display at the Katanning Art Gallery until Saturday 18 June 2022, is created by Kukerin artist Ken Lane with assistance from his wife Jane.

They are putting together a story about people living and working in the early 1800s to around the 1920s in the outback of Australia.

You'll see Pubs, Hotels, Garages, Tow trucks, Market Trucks, Fire Trucks, Police, Ambulance and, of course, the Hearse.

There will also be Goldmines,

Prospectors, Tour Guides, Farmers, Woodcutters, Shearers, Tourists and Bootleggers. To name just a few.

Each display model is made of nuts, bolts, plywood, and cardboard. All glued together and painted.

"Everyone in those days ... They all had an outside dunny ... and an obligatory Redback Spider to cope with.

The entire collection of hand-made models tells the story of the people from the small fictitious Western Australian outback town of Emu Creek.

It is about their lives, loves and dreams".

Application for Self-Supporting Loan - Katanning Country Club

Council authorised the Chief Executive Officer in accordance with the requirements of s6.20(2) of the Local Government Act 1995, to give one (1) month's local public notice of the Shire's intention to borrow \$250,000 at the estimated rate of 3.7% for the term of ten (10) years for the Katanning Country Club Redevelopment Project and to investigate options for securing the loan.

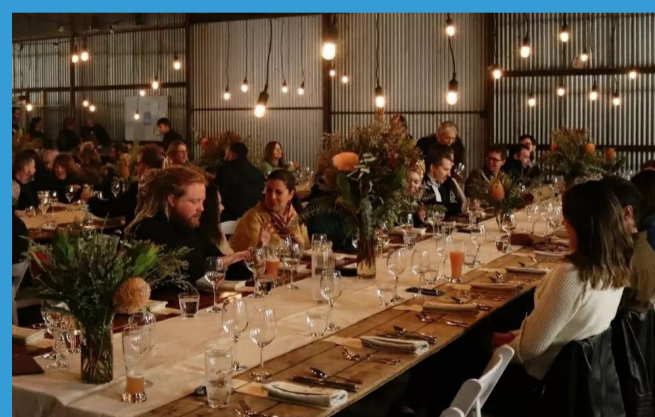
IMPORTANT DATES
